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Things You'll Need

1. [Update information at CMS's EHR Incentive Program Registration site.](#)
2. You must have an active Medicaid Provider Number. To enroll or check the status of your enrollment, call our Call Center at 505-246-9988, extension 8131288.
3. To learn about certified EHR vendors and products or to verify that your system is on the list from the Office of the National Coordinator for Health Information Technology (ONC), [click here.](#)
4. Identify an individual who will be the primary contact for your application - you'll need their name, phone and email.
5. Determine the Medicaid Patient volume you'll be reporting.
6. Locate the three most recent years of cost report data.
7. Ensure that you have access to a scanner or electronic faxing technology such as RightFax™.
8. Login and complete your application!

Patient Volumes

Eligible Hospitals must demonstrate 10% Medicaid discharges for a representative 90-day period in either: the previous fiscal year; or, the 12 months preceding the date of attestation. Your patient volume information must come from an auditable data source such as your hospital Cost Report.
